Not only is she stylish and comfortable, but the 56 has class wins in the ARC and has also won Cruising Class 1 at Antigua Sailing Week.

Oyster Blew is a four-cabin version with Reckmann Hydraulic Furling. She has just successfully completed the Oyster World Rally and is now in the Hamble UK.

Re-engined circa 2008, re-rigged in 2014 and now in 2020 she has also had a brand new composite deck fitted.
